AII. 20 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

AII. 21 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

AII. 22 COMMERCIAL STREET

a) Permission had been requested to erect a metal shed, to keep the existing pond and to continue the growth of a hedge (privet or hawthorn) to help with the security on plot number 30.

RESOLVED: To recommend that permission be granted for the shed and hedge but to specify the shed to be of a good construction and be removed at end of tenancy. No objections were made to keeping the existing pond, provided that if children were present to be extra vigilant.

b) Permission had been requested to erect a shed on plot number 34.

RESOLVED: To recommend that permission be granted but to specify, shed to be of a good construction and be removed at end of tenancy.

c) A letter had been received on behalf of the tenants on this site requesting a meeting to discuss the possibility of forming an Allotment Association.

RESOLVED: To contact Parish Councils and Town Councils who have Allotment Associations for details and information and a letter be written informing the tenants that further enquiries were being made and the Parish Council would be in touch as soon as possible.
