All. 26 ALLOTMENT ASSOCIATION - COMMERCIAL STREET

Discussion took place on the possibility of forming an Allotment Association at Commercial Street following a tenant's request.

RESOLVED: To recommend that the Council write to all tenants of this site indicating that a requirement of 60% of all tenants should be willing to form an association before the proposal can go ahead.
